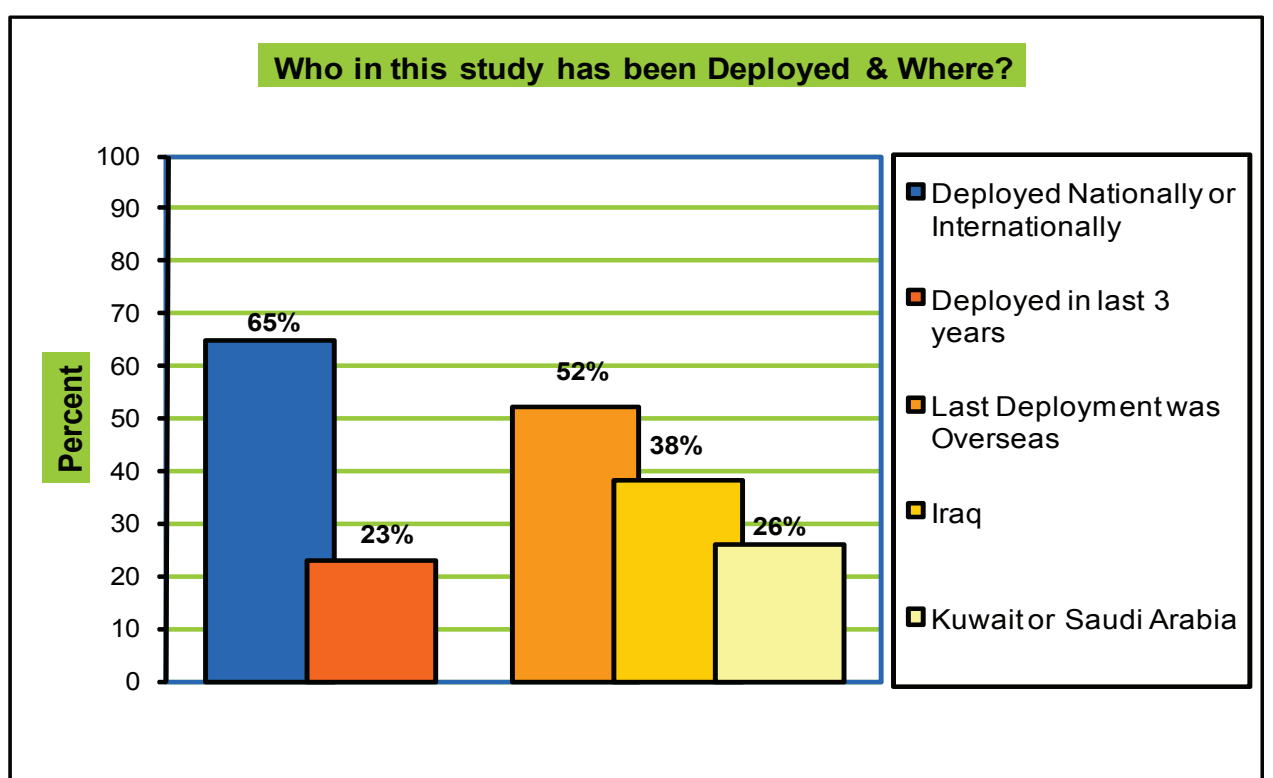
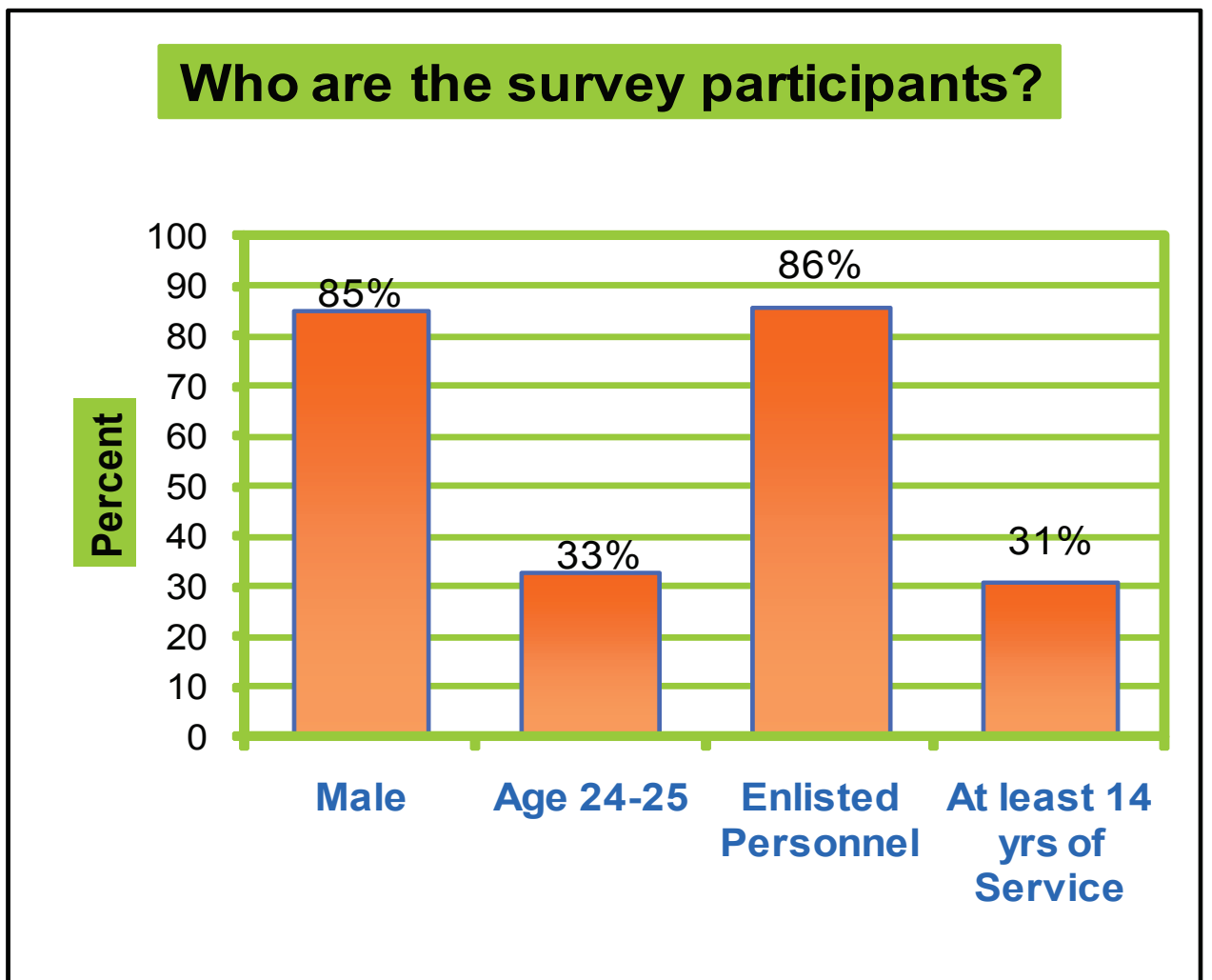
“We are very grateful to the Ohio National Guard members and their families for their exemplary service to our country and for their participation in this study.”
